**End of Year Giving:** To insure credit for 2011, donors must deliver checks on or by December 31 to claim a charitable contribution deduction for 2011. Checks that are placed in the church offering during the first worship service in 2012 will not qualify for a charitable contribution deduction in 2011, even if the check is predated to 2011 or was actually written in 2011. However, under the so-called "mailbox exception," checks that are written, mailed, and postmarked in 2011 will be deductible in 2011 though they are not received by the church until 2012.
